For instance, the 100,000-year cycles of ice ages are probably related to changes in the tilt of Earth's axis and the shape of its orbit around the sun. Those planetary factors change slowly over time and affect how much of the sun's energy reaches different parts of the world in different seasons. The impact of large meteorites on Earth could also cause climate change.

The impact of a meteor would send millions of tons of debris into the atmosphere. This debris would block at least some of the sun's rays, making it cold and dark. This climate change would severely limit what organisms could survive. Many palaeontologists believe the impact of a meteor or comet contributed to the extinction of the dinosaurs. Dinosaurs simply could not survive in a cool, dark climate. Their bodies could not adjust to the cold, and the dark limited the growth of plants on which they fed.

Plate tectonics also play a role in climate changes. Earth's continental plates have moved a great deal over time. More than 200 million years ago, the continents were merged together as one giant landmass called 'Pangaea'. As the continents broke apart and moved, their positions on Earth changed, and so did the movements of ocean currents. Both of these changes had effects on climate.


