

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What threat could small pieces pose to such massive infrastructure?

The size and weight of the pieces are secondary. What is crucial is that these pieces move at very great speeds. In the low earth orbit, where the targeted Indian satellite was located, objects typically move at almost 8 metres per second, or 28,000 km/ph, in order to stay in their orbits. At such speeds, even a tiny object of just about 100 grams would produce the same kind of impact on collision as a 30 kg stone travelling at about 100 km/hr. The debris from the destroyed Indian satellite would be typically moving at these speeds. A collision with any other satellite in space could render that satellite dysfunctional, if not destroy it.




