2. Trace the evolution of Public Administration since the days of Kautilya. 60
3. The Civil Service is the most important instrument for implementing people's will and aspirations as expressed in the Constitution. Discuss the role of Civil Services in Indian Administrative System. 60
4. 'In the wake of globalization, local democracy faces new issues and challenges.' Critically examine the major rural-urban development programmes and their management in India. 60
