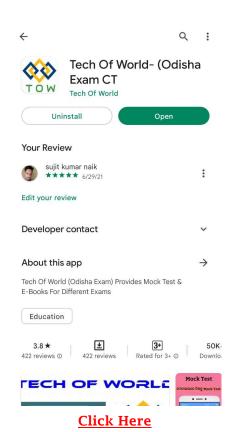

When one thinks of south-Indian food, the humble Idli is the first dish that comes to mind. To the uninitiated, this is a nice rice cake that is made by steaming a fermented mixture of rice and pulses. Idlis can also be made with semolina. In fact, there are many different types of Idlis. Some claim that there are over 1000 different variants of this delicacy. This dish is so popular that March 30th is celebrated every year as World Idli Day.

Though the Idli is today known as a south-Indian delicacy, it may have originated elsewhere. Many believe that the Idli came to India between 800-1200CE from Indonesia where it is known as a Kedli. Given the many links between south Indian rulers and Indonesian rulers, this is not very hard to believe.

Others believe that Arab traders introduced the Indian coasts to Idlis. These Arab traders had strict dietary norms and hence instead of eating the local food they ate flattened rice balls with a coconut paste.

There are a number of stories about the origins of the word 'Idli' as well. Some historians believe that the word, Idli, was derived from Iddalige, a word mentioned in the Vaddaradhane, a Kannada text by Sivakotyacharya in 920AD.

There are many who claim that it was derived from the word, Iddarika, a term mentioned in a 12th century Sanskrit text. There are some people who also claim that it was derived from a dish called Idada that was made by silk weavers from Saurashtra in 10AD. No matter where it came from and the process of making it is one that was perfected only in South-India.

Idlis are very healthy. They are easily digestible and can be eaten by children and adults of all ages. This is because the fermentation process breaks down the rice and dal into simple compounds. Fermentation also introduces good bacteria to the batter.

This makes the dish act as a probiotic and also help boost immunity. In addition, Idlis are rich sources of nutrients such as phytic acids, vitamin B, vitamin K, iron, and zinc. However, it has a low level of fats and carbohydrates. This makes it the ideal food for weight loss.

We must embark [President Truman said] on a bold new programme for making the benefits of our scientific advances and industrial progress available for the improvement and growth of underdeveloped areas. The old imperialism exploitation for foreign profit has no place in our plans. What we envisage is a programme of development based on the concepts of democratic fair dealing. By using the word underdevelopment for the first time in such a context, Truman changed the meaning of development and created a symbol and a concept which was later used as a cover for American domination. Never before had a word been universally accepted on the very day of its political coinage. A new perception was suddenly created. Two hundred years of social construction of the historical-political meaning of the term development were successfully stolen. A political and philosophical proposition of Marx packaged American style as a struggle against communism, succeeded in permeating both the popular and intellectual mind for the rest of the century. Underdevelopment began, then on January 20, 1949. On that day, two billion people became underdeveloped. In a real sense, from that time on, they ceased being what they were, in all their diversity, and were transformed into an inverted mirror of others reality: a mirror that belittles them and sends them off to the end of the queue, a mirror that defines their identity, which is really that of a heterogeneous and diverse majority, simply in the terms of a homogenising and narrow minority. Since then, development has connoted at least one thing: to escape from the undignified condition called underdevelopment. In order for someone to conceive the possibility of escaping from a particular condition, it is necessary first to feel that one has fallen into that condition. For those who make up two-thirds of the world's population today, to think of development of any kind of development requires first the perception of themselves as underdeveloped, with the whole burden of connotations that this carries.
